She is a Doctor of Art History and director of CITRONNE Gallery. She studied Museology and Art History, obtaining her PhD from Boston University in Massachusetts. She worked and organized exhibitions at the university gallery of Boston University, and subsequently taught at Boston College the History of European and American Art of the 19th and 20th centuries, as well as the History of Photography. In 2006, she founded the Citronne Gallery in Poros, and in 2018, it expanded to Athens.
